High School report cards will be emailed home April 11th, and Parent Teacher Interviews are April 16th.

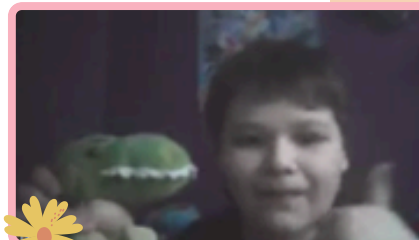
We hope that all of our students have a productive month in their classes. Keep up the great work!

Hybrid

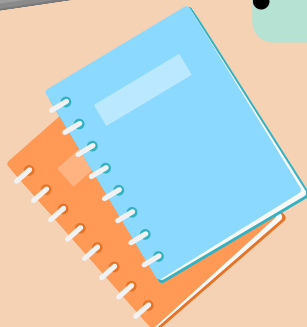

Hello, this is my 15th year with Northland School Division. I'm starting a new journey with the Online School team, and I'm so excited to help families learn and stay connected.



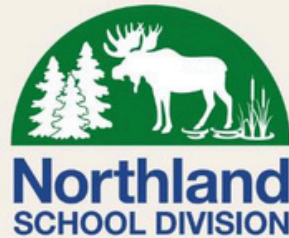
WHAT DOES A LIAISON WORKER DO?
